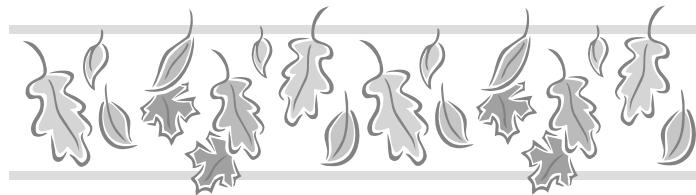

The Penn-Trafford School District does not carry insurance to cover the medical costs of participants in the adult education program. All participants enter the programs at their own risk.

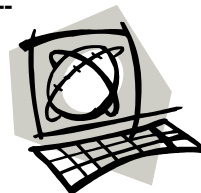
